Emily Lyle's neighbor, Lisa Murphy's family was at church last Sunday morning when a blaze engulfed their home. Investigators say it was an electrical fire that started in the kitchen. Lisa Murphy's pastor got word of the fire just before service began and told the family to rush home.

Sadly, the family is no stranger to tragedy. In the last three years, Lisa Murphy has lost her husband to cancer. A year after that, one of her daughters passed away and four of her children came to live with Lisa. Now she's left wondering what to do after the fire destroyed the house which had served as a safe place for a dozen children – many of them adopted – aged 2 to 20.
