#### Suggested school supplies are:

large book bags, clear book bags, 3-ring binders (1-inch to 3-inch), 5-tab divider sets, pens (blue, black and red), highlighters, mechanical pencils and refill pencil lead, colored folders (prongs or not), calculators (Scientific), hand sanitizer, tissues (small packets), crayons (24-count only), wooden pencils & pencil sharpeners, pencil holders/bags for inside notebooks, envelopes—white, small & large, rulers, compasses and protractors, spiral notebooks (1-subject mainly, also 3- & 5-), notebook paper (wide & college rule), index cards (3x5; ruled; white and colored) colored pencils, staplers and staples, markers (10-pack), copy paper, tri-folder notebook with 3 sides, Trapper Keepers, tape, glue sticks, scissors, liquid white out, sanitary wipes, dry erase markers
