Look closely and you will recognize some familiar ministries being done in different ways in order to reach different people who are living in a different time and context.

PPC has survived the ups and downs of history for 190 years. With a renewed commitment to God through radical hospitality, passionate worship, intentional faith development, risk taking mission and service, and extravagant generosity PPC can and will become all that God intends.
