WHERE ARE WE NOW?

After weeks of hard work and prayerful discernment the committee to nominate the PNC presented the following slate that was unanimously approved by congregational vote on July 24.

Primary (serving with voice and vote) - Barbara Barlow, Greg Downing, Marie Dossouvi, Emory Pearce and Mary Smith.

Alternates (with voice only): Debbie Bray and Darr Johnson who will be able to step in should a primary be unable to serve.

The PNC will meet with Ann Grier, the PNC Liaison for PPC who will provide an overview of the search process. She (and Joy Fisher, our Congregational Consultant) will also offer guidance for the PNC during the coming months.

After building community, deciding on devotions, reviewing resources and drafting a timeline, the PNC will begin its work which is neither simple nor easy. Initial tasks will involve:

- Creating a draft of the Ministry Information Form (MIF) in consultation with the Liaison, incorporating information from the CAT Scan, listening session, current demographic information and projections, and other sources
- Reaching agreement on potential Terms of Call, including financial considerations, with the Session and with counsel from their Liaison and/or Congregational Consultant
- Once the Liaison and Congregational Consultant approve the MIF, it is reviewed with Session for input and approval unless there are recommendations for substantive changes
- In consultation with the CC and Liaison, the PNC decides on the places to advertise the position
- PNC Chair posts the MIF for PPC with the national office of the PC(USA) to secure matches with potential candidates
- PIF's (i.e., resume's) of potential candidates are received and reviewed
- The PNC narrows their list, Presbytery performs background checks, interviews are conducted and the selection of a finalist is made

The Good Shepherd Clinic invites everyone to its thirteenth annual Tomato Sandwich Party fundraiser on Saturday, August 6th, 2016 at the Morrow Center located at Southlake Mall. This year's Tomato Sandwich Party will be held from 5-7:30 p.m. A minimum donation at the door will be \$15 per person. The menu includes a variety of food and drink featuring make-your-own tomato sandwiches, a salsa bar, a pickle bar, and dessert. Local entertainment will be provided by Faculty Grass and a Jazz Trio.

There is a tremendous need for medical care in Clayton County, the poorest in metro Atlanta. The clinic averages 3,000 patient encounters a year.

The <u>Good Shepherd Clinic</u> is a faith-based, non-profit organization that provides free medical care for uninsured residents of Clayton County. The Tomato Sandwich Party is the Clinic's major community fundraising event each year. The 2015 Tomato Sandwich Party raised over \$50,000. Our goal in 2016 is \$55,000.
