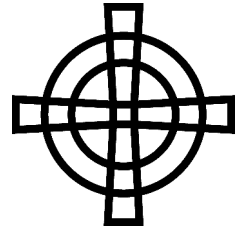

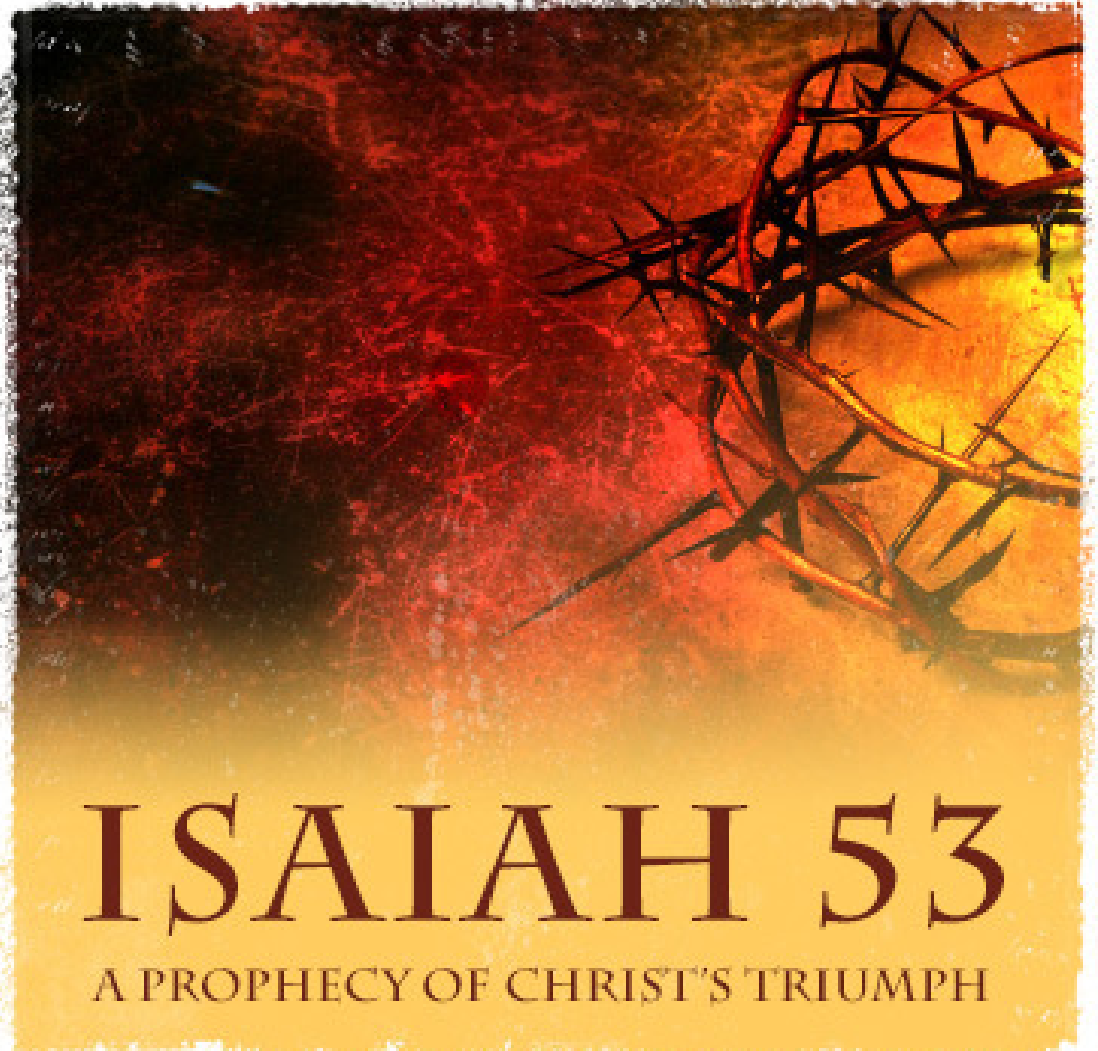

The Session of Philadelphia Presbyterian Church held its monthly business meeting on March 18, 2018. The Financial Committee reported the PPC January 2018 financial report as follows:

Total Revenue February	\$13,134.47
Total Expenses February	\$8,648.46
Balance for February	\$4,486.01
Balance in the Operating Fund	\$30,057.98
Total Assets *	\$64,204.05

*(This includes operating fund, money market, and investments in cd's)

YTD Revenue	\$22,244.11
YTD Expenses	\$17,737.17
Difference of	\$4,506.94

In other news:

This year it was decided that we would NOT have an Easter Sunrise service this year. Over the years our participation level has greatly decreased so we decided to not hold it. However, Session is going to host an Easter breakfast at 9:30 a.m. and this will take the place of Sunday school. Everyone is invited to breakfast and we hope you will come.

The Stations of the Cross will go up the week before Easter. Since Easter is on April 1st – which would also be Communion Sunday – we have decided to reschedule communion to April 8th.

Many "Thanks" to everyone who donated either money, clothing, or both to the family in Forest Park. We collected \$150 which was used to purchase a gift card to give to the family. At this time, the family doesn't have a permanent residence so we haven't been able to deliver the clothing that was collected but we hope to do so soon.

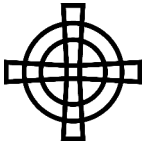

ITEMS NEEDED

SECUR'US HOUSE is Clayton County's organization that provides a refuge for women and their children in a time of crisis. We will be collecting supplies in April to donate to the shelter to meet their needs.

Items for infants & children include:

diapers (all sizes, but esp. large & x-large)
diaper rash cream
baby oil, baby wipes & Vaseline
bottles with nipples
diaper bags & baby strollers
socks, underwear & undershirts (all sizes)
pajamas & slippers (all sizes)
crayons, coloring books, markers

Items for the women include:

new underwear (all sizes)
pajamas, gowns & slippers (all sizes)
personal hygiene products
hair care products for women of all color
hair blow dryers
casual clothes (all sizes)
folders for personal documents

Items for the shelter include:

toiletries (deodorant, shampoo bar soap)
laundry detergent & fabric softener
dish-washing detergent (hand & machine)
paper towels, toilet tissue & facial tissues
trash bags (large kitchen & heavy-duty yard)
toothbrushes, toothpaste & mouthwash
first aid products; cough drops; lip balm
Infant & Children's Tylenol (non-generic)
twin sheets sets (any color)
white towels
wash cloths
9-oz. & 16-oz. cups
paper plates
office supplies
8 ½ x 11 copy paper
Post-it notes (all sizes)
9 x 12 manila envelopes
