Fall is coming, and the temperatures are already cooler. And with fall, not only do we have the business of school starting, but we crank back up circle lessons, budget preparations, congregational meetings, election of officers for 2023, and special events in the life of the church. We have Labor Day, World Communion Sunday, Reformation Sunday, All Saints Sunday, Veterans Day, Thanksgiving and then it's Advent!

So here are a number of upcoming events to get excited about:

Some of us PW will be at Epworth by the Sea October 21-23 for the triennial Synod PW gathering. If you haven't signed up yet, it's not too late! The Bible Study author, Carol Bechtel, will be there, as well as other great preachers and workshops. The women will also have a retreat at Camp Calvin Saturday October 29, and I will lead a discussion of the different themes of the Psalms. All ladies are welcome, and I encourage you to bring a friend!

On December 17 at 3:00, the choir will treat us to a Christmas Cantata and we will have a cookie reception afterwards. This will be on a Saturday afternoon like last year.

December 24, Saturday, is the Christmas Eve service, and December 25 is Sunday this year. Watch for a poll from Greg Durden in the next few weeks to see if a 3:00 time for Christmas Eve would be better, and if you would prefer that I post a Christmas message on Facebook for Christmas day rather than having services at the church.

So buckle your seat belts – it's going to be a fun but fast ride the rest of the year, and we will have some great opportunities to worship God in special ways!
