Well, summer has finally decided to show up with its heat and humidity. Just in time for teachers and students to return to school. I hope you are enjoying the summer still even though it has become quite warm most days.

The Session did meet on Tuesday, July 18, 2023, via Zoom to conduct our monthly business. For the month of June, our financial information was as follows:

Total Assets - \$95,257.49 Monthly Total Revenue - \$12,002.42 YTD Revenue - \$85,177.63 Monthly Total Expenses - \$15,942.03 YTD Expenses - \$79,372.33

As always, your continued financial support is greatly appreciated!!! For a small church, we are mighty faithful with our tithing. Thank you so very much!!! We could not do the work of the church without your support.

In the Narthex you will now find the Church Project sheet as promised. Please help us by listing ideas for things that need to be repaired/updated before Homecoming. Don't forget that we have set a date – October 12, 2025. Please start looking around the Church – inside and out – to see what needs to be spruced up. We have now replaced all the faucets in the bathrooms and are now looking at repairing the steps at the entrance to the church. There has also been a tree removed from behind the sanctuary in the Memory Garden and trees have been trimmed along the drive going into the cemetery. If we start working on items now, then it will not be so overwhelming to accomplish in 2025.
