YTD Expenses - \$171,965.63.

While our December expenses increased slightly, our total revenue for the year exceeded our total expenses by \$5,680.21. God is Good! We begin the year with Rev. Jeanne and husband, Jim, off on a grand Pacific adventure. We pray that their travels are safe and rewarding and that they return in good health. Meanwhile, we are blessed to have Rev. Jack and Rev. Katie filling the pulpit in their absence.

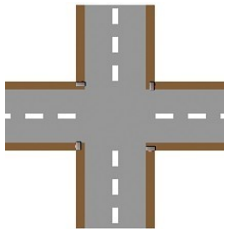
