HONORING OUR MILITARY

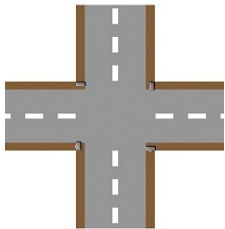
If you or anyone in your family are or were in the military, bring a military picture to display on our table of honor. If you need to bring in the picture early, see Connie McWilliams.
