It's time to decompress and watch the final football championship games. Although, depending on whether your team is in one of them, it may be a little stressful! We will celebrate Epiphany on January 5 and the Baptism of the Lord on January 12, and then we will enter "ordinary" or "ordinal" time (because the weeks are counted as numeric "propers" or church services) until March 5, when Lent begins with Ash Wednesday.

During ordinary time, I'm always reminded that we use the color green, which to me signifies fertility and growth. It's a time of studying our faith and celebrating our blessings. It's a time of sitting in front of the fireplace as the days get dark so much earlier.
