THE CROSSROADS

We have been through 40 days of Lent. We have celebrated Palm Sunday and pondered the confrontations in the temple and Jerusalem that caused Jesus to be arrested and condemned to death. We have suffered through Good Friday and Holy Saturday – praying and wondering in silence how the Messiah could have been betrayed and murdered so quickly. And then on Easter Sunday, we moved from darkness and silence into the light of resurrection.

In May, we will worship in Eastertide, as we look at the post-resurrection appearances by Jesus and the growing certainty by the disciples that this teacher was in fact the Holy Son of God. These disciples will begin to think anew about carrying on Jesus' legacy until we celebrate in June Pentecost, when the flames of the new church of Christ are born. As we look in wonder at the explosion of flowers and greenery around us as Spring and longer days arrive, let us remember that we are invited to follow the path that Jesus showed us with his death and resurrection.
